

# SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

AT SAINT JOHN BOSCO COLLEGE, UNIFORM IS COMPULSORY  
FOR ALL STUDENTS IN YEARS 7-11



- Dark blue blazer with embroidered school logo
- Dark grey jumper embroidered school logo
- Mid grey trousers or mid grey skirt that must be at least knee length
- Black, smart polishable school shoes
- Heels should be flat (no higher than 3 cm)
- Plain black, white, navy blue or dark grey socks or tights
- School tie to be worn with buttoned shirt (boys only)
- Water-proof, warm winter coat, gloves, hat and scarf (black, grey and navy blue)
- Practical rucksack or black school bag large enough to carry textbooks and school equipment



- No trainers or pumps, high heels, suede shoes, boots, Crock-style shoes or sliders
- Ankle or other winter boots (including 'Ugg'- style boots) are not to be worn inside the building.
- No hoodies, sweatshirts, baseball caps and other similar items

## YEAR 7 - 9

- White button to the neck shirt, (boys)
- white blouse (girls)

## YEAR 10 - 11

- Light blue button to the neck shirt (boys)
- light blue blouse (girls)

## PE KIT

- Polo shirt with school logo
- PE jumper with school logo (optional)
- Navy school shorts with logo, plain navy tracksuit bottoms or skirt
- Sports socks
- Trainers



## Jewellery

### STUDENT CAN WEAR

- A wrist watch (we would discourage the wearing of smart watches).
- One small pair of plain gold or silver studs no more than 4mm in diameter (one in each ear only).
- A religious necklace which must be worn out of sight inside the shirt/blouse.

### STUDENT MUST NOT

- Have any facial jewellery or tongue piercings. Covering any jewellery not permitted by the behaviour policy with a plaster is not permitted.
- The school accepts no responsibility for any financial issues or risk of infection that arises when students are asked to remove piercings.

### STUDENT CAN HAVE

- Dyed hair, but natural colours (i.e. a colour a person could grow naturally) only are acceptable.
- Long hair should be tied back, off the face with a blue or black clip or band with no hair covering the eyes or ears.
- Subtle makeup that is natural in appearance; it should not be noticeable by staff.

### STUDENT MUST NOT

- Wear coloured nail varnish.
- Shave part of their heads.
- Wear false nails or bring false nails & glue to school.
- Wear false eyelashes.
- Wear coloured/patterned contact lenses.
- Bring makeup to school.

Parents should provide a dark blue or black warm winter coat, scarf and gloves.

Students must not come to school in the cold or wet weather wearing only their blazer.
