Uniform Expectations

Students have the option to wear either Uniform A or Uniform B, as detailed below.

If a student chooses to wear a revered collar blouse, and therefore not wear the school tie with house stripes, they must have their house badge sewn onto their blazer pocket.

Uniform A	Uniform B
- black blazer with the school badge (there is no need to have the house badge on the blazer pocket, as the tie dictates this) - white, plain shirt with school tie in house colour - plain black V-neck jumper (optional) - black (tailored, straight legged) trousers - plain outdoor coat (not to be worn in learning spaces) - black shoes (not canvas, trainers or boots) - short white or black socks	- black blazer with the school badge and your house badge on the blazer pocket - white, plain revere collar blouse with no tie - plain black V-neck jumper (optional) - black TKC trousers or plain TKC skirt - plain outdoor coat (not to be worn in learning spaces) - black shoes (not canvas, trainers or boots) - black or neutral tights or short white or black socks
Additional Uniform Information	
- jewellery – one watch and only one stud earring in each ear (no additional piercings are acceptable) - natural unpainted nails (no false, acrylic or gel nails) - minimal makeup (so it cannot be noticed) - Hoodies and logo jumpers/sweatshirts are not acceptable TKC uniform and will be confiscated if seen. - Items which are confiscated will be held in the office until a parent/carer is able to collect it.	
TKC PE Kit	
- The TKC PE kit has the TKC logo on it - TKC black and white polo shirt - TKC games shorts - TKC black and white training joggers (optional) - TKC multisport long-sleeved top (optional) - plain trainers – not overly colourful and must be sporty in style - all students in Year 7 to 11 must wear the TKC PE kit for PE lessons and any other sporting event, as directed by PE staff	

All students at Thomas Knyvett College are expected to wear full uniform at all times. If a student is required to wear trainers for medical reasons, they should have a note from a medical practitioner.

Any student who is in incorrect uniform, or refuses to amend their uniform when asked, will be out of circulation until the uniform can be resolved.
