| Plimsolls/trainers          | Any colour(will change into these for PE) | Yes                      | Any retailer                              |
| Swimming costume            | Any colour                                | Yes – Year 4-6 only      | Any retailer                              |
| Drawstring bag              | Navy Blue                                 | No                       | Any retailer                              |

## **Purchasing**

The school jumper or cardigan and sports top are the only compulsory items that include the school logo and must be purchased through our school uniform supplier (School Uniform Direct <https://www.schooluniformdirect.co.uk/>). All other items are readily available from high street stores. Our uniform has been kept simple to avoid unnecessary expense.

## **Jewellery**

Pupils should not wear jewellery to school except where a pupil has pierced ears; small plain studs are acceptable.

## **Watches**

Watches may be worn to school, however they must be removed before any PE lessons and given to the class teacher for safekeeping.

## **Hair and Make-Up**

No make-up or nail varnish should be worn. Long hair should be tied back during physical education lessons for safety.

## **Role of the Class Teachers and Support Staff**

- To set a good example in terms of dress
- To remember that in our respective roles we serve the local community as a set of professionals
- To wear clothing in line with the staff code of conduct

## **Role of the Head teacher and Governing Body**

- The Head teacher will ensure that pupils comply with the school uniform policy agreed by the Governing Body
- Children who come to School not wearing correct school uniform will be asked to borrow a school top from the School Office to wear over their own clothes and this should be returned at the end of the school day and parents will be informed
- To review the rationale and implementation of the school uniform at regular points

### **Role of the Parents/Carers**

- To ensure that their child/children adhere to the School Uniform Policy
- To ensure that they come to School in uniform every day unless there are special circumstances such as sports day, themed days or charity fundraising events
- Label all items of clothing and footwear with your child's name

### **Racial Equality and Equal Opportunities**

All children have equal access to wearing school uniform regardless of their culture, race, religion, gender, disability or ability. We ensure that the set uniform respects other policies such as Race Relations, Sex Discrimination and allows for individual sets of circumstances of all groups and individuals. Ravenstone Primary School is committed to creating a positive climate that will enable everyone to work free from intimidation and harassment and to achieve their full potential.
